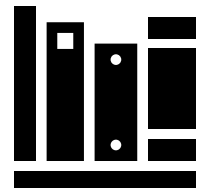
## CLASS PROCEDURES

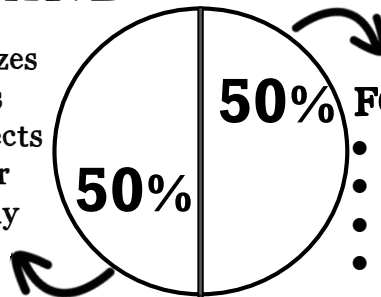
